## FDL EOC DIRECTIVE 20-001

### CANCELLATION AND PROHIBITION OF IN-PERSON EVENTS

#### Section 1. Findings

- a. The Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic has infected more than 44 million people worldwide, to include more than 8.8 million people in the United States, and more than 142,000 in Minnesota. 31 cases have been confirmed within the boundaries of the Fond du Lac Reservation, and both Saint Louis and Carlton Counties in Minnesota and Douglas County in Wisconsin have seen recent significant increases in infections.
- b. The FDL Band Emergency Operations Center (EOC), in consultation with Band health care professionals, having examined the current circumstances and the potential for increased community spread of COVID-19 has determined that it is not in the Band's best interest to allow, sponsor, or host large-scale, in-person events which are normally conducted during the year.

#### Section 3. Cancellation and Prohibition of In-Person Events

- a. All Band sponsored in-person events, to include Holiday parties or gatherings, are cancelled. The use of technology and other alternate means of gathering consistent with Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Band Public Health guidance is directed for all Band-sponsored activities.
- b. Private in-person events in which more than five (5) people gather and which are being held on Reservation lands are prohibited. See RBC Resolution 1173/20. Private persons are encouraged to use technology and alternate means of gathering consistent with CDC and Band Public Health guidance.
